Over recent years we have invested a good deal of money on large build projects across all 3 Rescue Centres with the intention of bringing our animal welfare facilities up to scratch. The good news is, and we hope that you would agree, we have achieved considerable success in this regard; the bad news is that, in order to maintain our sound financial base, further improvements will have to take place at a rather more leisurely pace.

So, for the Christmas appeal this year we have invited each Centre to nominate a smaller, but still very worthwhile project, as the target for their fundraising efforts over the coming months. This approach has two main advantages. First, it allows you to support a project at your local Centre which, quite understandably, some of you may prefer. Second, we have set opening targets of up to

£8,000 for the projects and the Trustees have agreed to match £ for £ the money raised up to a limit of £4,000 in each case. Refurbishment of the Vales Cat Cabins

The Vales is the original cattery which is very old and outdated as well as being an eyesore. The funds will be spent on refurbishing the cabins and improving the furniture, repairing the porches, runs and concrete base plus levelling and re-fencing the small adjacent goat paddock. The result will be a much improved animal welfare facility for our cats, rabbits, ex-battery hens and wildlife, particularly birds, in an attractive setting.

The hospital facility is a real success story and we now want to improve further the treatment and care available. Our shopping list includes: the purchase of dental equipment, the fitting of additional radiators and the conversion of one of the hospital kennels into a dedicated recovery room with bigger and better cages. Together these measures will minimise the stressful waiting and travel times for our animals whilst providing excellent aftercare all year round.

Rescue Cattery

The Rescue Cattery is now in need of some serious TLC to match the superb level of care provided by the staff to the rescued cats. The priorities are to: relay the concrete floors in the exercise pens and security corridor including appropriate drainage; provide drainage to the garden which is the centrepiece of the cattery; refurbish the interior of the cat pens; re-lay internal floors as appropriate; maintain the sidewalls and roof.
